Dear Resident of Cherry Hill,

As you know, over the last few years there have been considerable debates and discussions about the on street parking at Cherry Hill.

As you will be aware, the properties on the estate are covered by a Covenant that covers on street parking (Schedule 3 Paragraph 10), which states that the roads or footpaths should not be obstructed by parked vehicles.

This covenant is difficult to enforce and the on street parking in Cherry Hill is seen by many residents as a major issue.

In order that the Council has a good idea of what the Residents of Cherry Hill would prefer, we are conducting this consultation to gather your views.
